

## WALK from the 'Old Haa', Burravoe to Ladies Hole (Circular)

On leaving the Ulsta ferry terminal, turn right along the B9081 to Burravoe and the 'Old Haa' museum and visitor centre.



Head north from the 'Old Haa' and take a right turn at St. Colman's church. Turn left along the road marked to Neepaback and Burravoe Pier, then turn right down the short road to Burravoe Pier. Here you will find some very good information signs for visitors and even some picnic tables and chairs.



From the pier it's fairly easy to climb over the metal gate and head north-east along the path by the side of the voe.



After a few hundred yards, cross a stile beside a red gate and continue north-east across Hellia Dale towards the sea.



The occasional otter might be spotted on the rocks in this area. Climb north up the cliff side from here to Ladies Hole, where puffins can be seen at the right time of year.

To return from the top of the cliff, cross the stile over the fence behind the houses and take the road to Upper Neepaback.



From here, follow the road down the hill back to the 'Old Haa' at Burravoe.
