

WALK from GUE to CRUSSA FIELD

On the approach to Baltasound (A968) follow the road to Baliasta and on to Gue. From here, climb the gentle slope north-east to Crussa Field and the massive Viking longhouse. This remarkable longhouse has unusually large stones outlining its base, and it looks like many of the smaller stones have been removed for building purposes by more recent settlers.



Close by the longhouse there is a clear stone circle, indicating a burial ground.



From this site, follow the dry stone wall south-west to the south end of the Loch of Cliff. On a small peninsula jutting out on the loch there is another much smaller example of a Viking longhouse complete with stone circle.



From the south end of the loch, head south-east back to Gue. Directly south of the inhabited croft house, in the field beside the road, is yet another very clear example of a Viking longhouse.
