Key Points for Newsletter/Website	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The MPIS members supported the idea for us to pilot the OPEN Online workshop with Primary 7 at Bellsbrae and Sound Primary Schools. This idea has come following discussions with staff and P7 pupils in Bellsbrae that are aware of issues around online bullying going on. • We will contact both schools and aim to deliver the workshop in Term 4 with P7's, we will consider our methods in how to evaluate the pilot. For example, pre and post course questionnaire. • We will still aim to deliver the OPEN Online workshop in every Junior and high school in 2018-19 but will evaluate this in a way which will help us identify what age might be most appropriate. For Example, a pre and post course questionnaire. Then comparing P7 and S1 results to identify content and knowledge about staying safe online. • Kerri, school nurse also spoke about how we could use the S3 Health Checks to evaluate pupils' knowledge on issues around Online safety and figure out if we are increasing awareness in the long term. • Kerri was discussing the updated School Nurses Service, we should be looking at signposting pupils to school nurses as well as or instead of PSE teachers. We can raise awareness by highlighting at the end of OPEN workshops how a pupil can self-refer directly to school nurses or through their teacher.
