Willing to support the work of the group going forward including research and sharing what's happening on other areas.</li> <li>• Coastguard – no senior person in post hoping to rectify that within the next few weeks they have had 37 incidents in the last month they are also changing their watch system.</li> <li>• Scottish Ambulance report very positive, should have a full complement of staff fully trained by the end of the year. Moving into shared premises with Fire Service and think this is a very positive change.</li> <li>• Local Fire report – False alarms is the figure that is high 44% mostly in schools and hospital and predominately in Lerwick, working with those involved to go through a reduction decision matrix. The new recruitment model where fireman can be trained locally is having a good effect, 18 new applications. Two new rapid response vehicles to be deployed in the islands. new station commander started.</li> <li>• Policing – positive report with all areas seeing reductions, their framework has been developed around the monitoring and reporting back on the LOIP.
